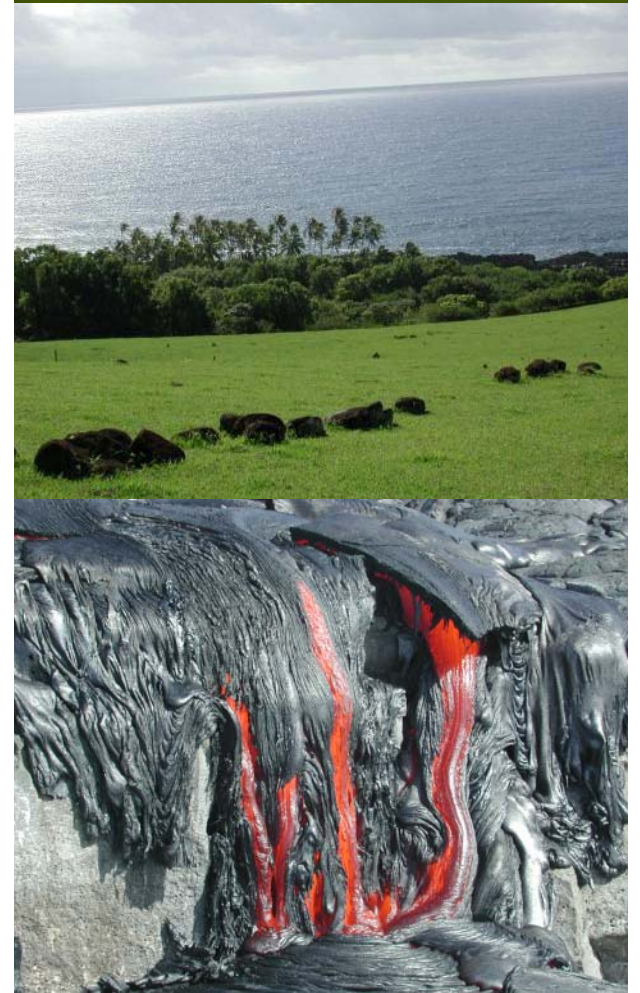

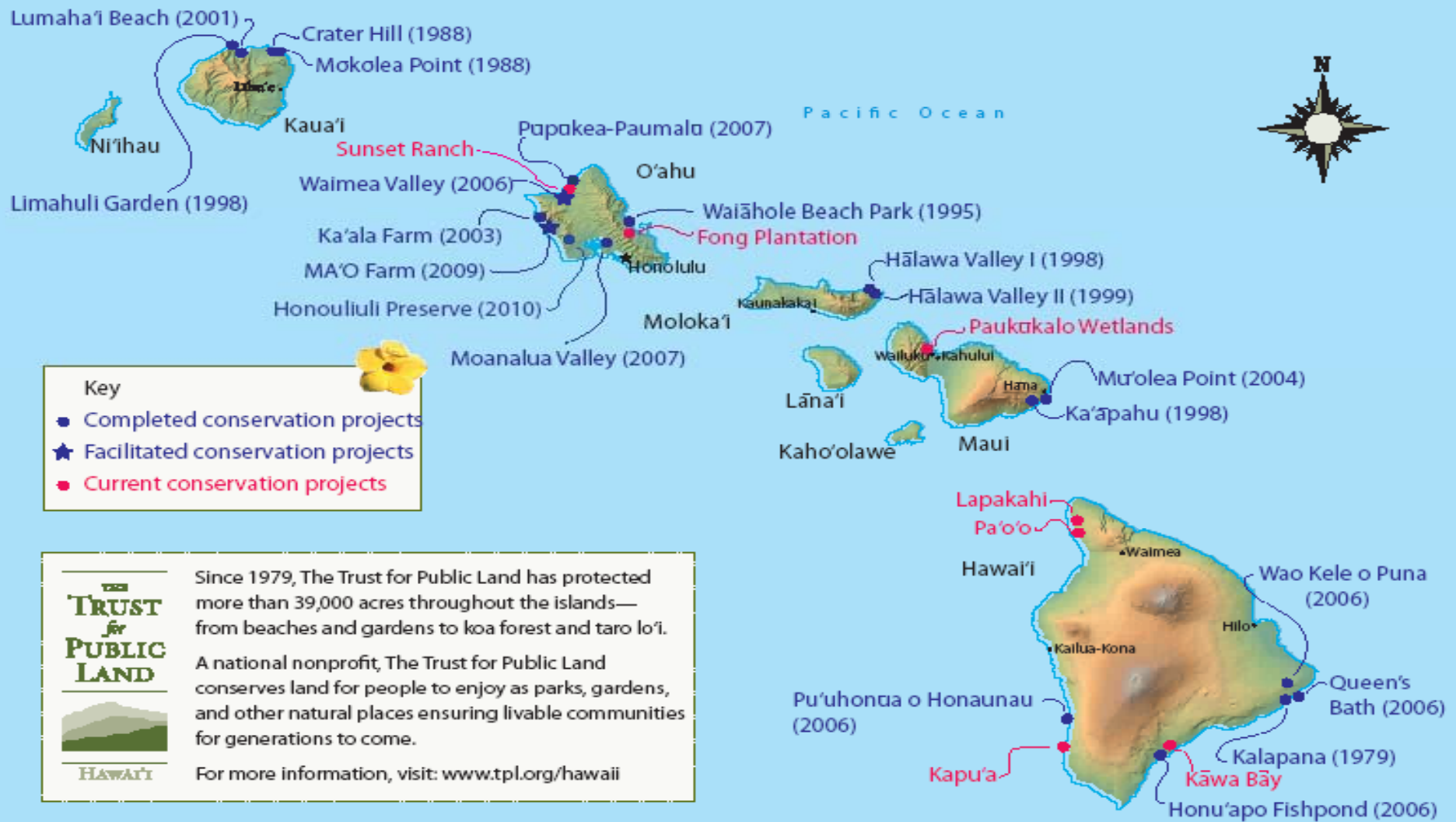

Funding Sources

- Natural Resources Conservation Service, Farm & Ranchland Protection Program \$1.2 million
- State Legacy Land Conservation Fund - \$600,000
- Honolulu Clean Water & Natural Lands Fund - \$600,000
- Total: \$2.4 million - 27 acres ag conservation easement
